NOTICE OF LIABILITY

Whilst the FOP Friends' Safari Weekend (Weekend) has been paid for by a grant from the Russell Lang Charitable Trust and organised by FOP Friends (herein referred to collectively as FOP Friends), neither organisation takes any responsibility for any loss or damage to persons or property (including cars, wheelchairs, electronic devices and other equipment) incurred whilst taking part in the Weekend. Everyone who attends does so at their own risk.

There will be no childcare provided by FOP Friends at this Weekend. Parents will have full responsibility for their children at all times, including their child/ren's behaviour. There will be no creche facilities at the evening dinner on Saturday evening.

There is a small adventure theme park at West Midlands Safari Park. On request, wristbands will be provided for attendees to enjoy the rides. It is the responsibility of the parents and individuals to assess each ride for its suitability based on their medical condition/s and health. **FOP Friends takes no responsibility for any injury or flare up resulting from riding the attractions. People ride at their own risk.**

Spring Grove House and Arley Arboretum both have stairs within their venue. We, FOP Friends and guests, do not have access to the upper levels and the stairs have been cordoned off. There is no reason for anyone – adult or child – to use these staircases. **It is the responsibility of the parents to ensure their child/ren do not play on the stairs, move the cordon, or go up the stairs.** These stairs will not be supervised. Parents are required to enforce this with their own child/ren. FOP Friends, West Midlands Safari Park and Arley House accept no responsibility for any injury should these instructions be ignored and an incident occurs.

There are no medical services on site or First Aiders. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian/individual to take all the necessary medication and information that they may need at the weekend. There is a Boots and a B&M at Weavers Wharf for any over-the-counter medicine.

In an emergency, please call NHS 111 or 999.

FOP Friends is not responsible for any breakages or damage to the rooms at the Premier Inn.

In the event of any breakages or damage to the room, the guest will be wholly liable for any clean up, repair or replacement charges. In the event of Premier Inn contacting us after the weekend to recoup charges, FOP Friends will pass on the contact details of the family who resided in that lodge. When signing this agreement, you give permission for FOP Friends to pass on your address for the purpose of resolving the issue. **The dispute will then be between Premier Inn and the guest; FOP Friends will not be involved.**

FOP Friends is not liable for any parking fines incurred. It is the responsibility of guests to read any parking signage and ensure the correct fees are paid prior to parking. **This includes Blue Badge holders, who are only entitled to a limited time of free parking at Weavers Wharf.**
